
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Introduction

Affiliate Funnel Builder is a software that allows you to create responsive affiliate funnels for any affiliate product of your choice with just some clicks. Here's a screenshot of it.

Creating Your First Affiliate Funnel

First, enter your affiliate link (for the product that you want to promote)
Right here:



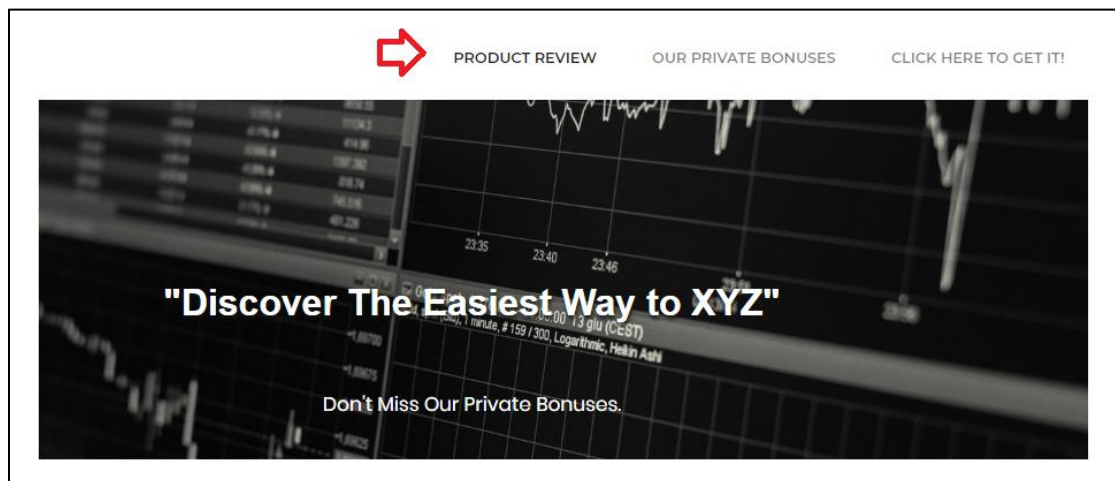

And here's how the menu bar looks like...



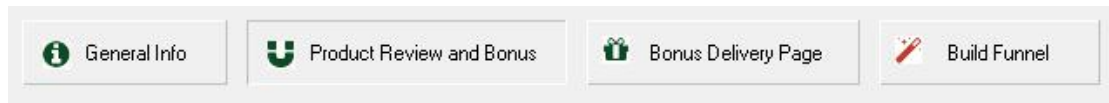
Comment: You'll see an option to configure a link for the "Bonuses" section (if you're offering one or more bonuses - it's highly recommended to boost your affiliate conversions).

Preparing Your Review Page

Now we'll jump to the second tab ("Product Review and Bonus") ...



The review page has different sections. The first one is the header which includes an image with a title + sub-title.



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You can configure the elements of this area from here the **"Header"** section.

The review begins with a "Hero" section which will give a good look to your affiliate review page.

From here you can enter your review with the following structure:

- Headline
- Review Intro
- Product Image
- Review End

Review

Then we have the **“Video”** section:

Using a video is optional but if the product creator has prepared one, don't miss the chance to use it.

Headline:

(leave this field empty if you don't want to use a video).

In the following example, the video ID is the part of a YouTube url that you see in Blue:

Comment: A video helps your readers to get more detailed info of the product / service that you're promoting. In general, you should find one or more YouTube videos for hot converting products (made by the product creator etc). If so, then try to add one to your review as it will surely help you.

Adding a bonus (“Your Bonuses” section): Adding a bonus (for those who buy the affiliate product through your affiliate link), can absolutely help you to improve your conversions.

If you can take two minutes to add a bonus, please do it.

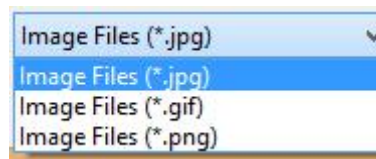
To add a bonus (up to 3), please follow these steps:

Step 1: Pick a cover of the bonus (or any image of the bonus that could help).

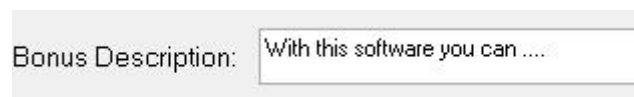
You can do it from this button...



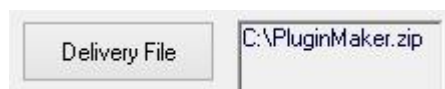
Tip: By default, the selector allows you to select “JPG” files, but you can look for other files using the drop-down box:



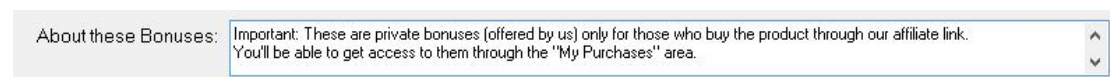
Step 2: Enter a description of the bonus.



Step 3: Select the file that those who buy through your link will download (the delivery file for this bonus).



You can also add a special note at the end of your bonuses (you could mention that these are private bonuses for those who buy through your affiliate link, and you could also mention how to get access to these bonuses - depending on the affiliate network that you’re using).



Finally, you can tweak other things (page title, custom button etc) from the “More Settings” tab:



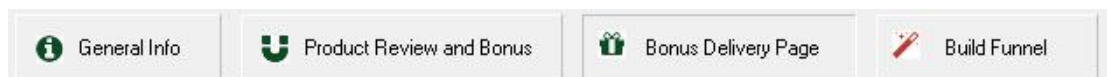
Pro Version

In the “Pro” version you can add a “Retargeting” ad code (Facebook etc), To keep on selling related products to all the people who visit your review page.

This is really cool and it could put more money in your pocket for years to come!

If you plan to use this feature, simply paste your retargeting code (please check with your advertising platform - for example: facebook ads - for more details on how to get your retargeting code).

If you’re offering one or more bonuses, then the software will create a “Bonus Delivery” page for you, which you can customize through the “Bonus Delivery Page” tab.



This page will be created with the “download.html” name and you can later rename it to whatever you want (example: download9sf.html).

Tip: In the delivery page, you can add an opt-in form. This is good build a “Buyers” list.

Creating Your Funnels:

To create your funnel, simply go to “Build Funnel” and then create your funnel. That’s all.

Uploading Your Website:

You can upload your websites to any hosting provider, free or paid.

If you upload it to a free hosting provider, in most of the cases you won’t need to register a domain name as the free hosting provider will create a subdomain or subfolder for you.

Something like:

yourusername.freehostingurl.com

Or

Freehostingurl.com/yourusername

Please look for a service that provides “FTP” (so you can easily upload your website through an FTP software).

If you have your own domain + a paid hosting, you're surely familiar with these things.

Once you have a hosting account (free or paid), it's time to upload your website to the web.

If you don't have an FTP client, i recommend you CoreFTP (but you can use others of course).

You can get it from this url (the Free version is ok):



After installing it, click the “Site Manager” button.



From the site manager you can keep the FTP info of all your websites (if you have many).

Once you click it, you'll be able to enter the info of a new website:

Basically, you'll enter 3 values:

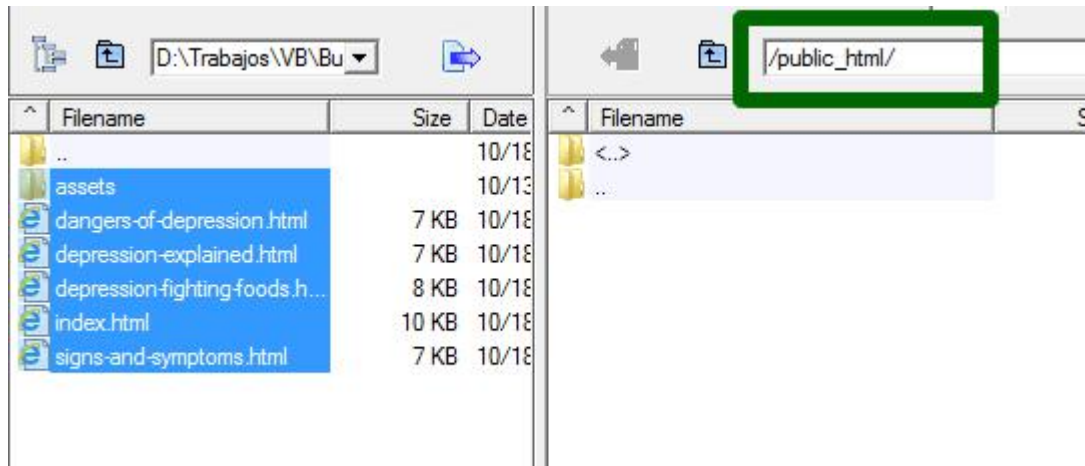
Host
Username
Password

Your web hosting provider will give you this info. If you didn't receive it, please contact them requesting it (tell them that you need the FTP login details: Hostname, User & Pass).

After entering this info, click "Connect".

After connecting... the right panel will show the folder of your website. You should see a folder named “public_html” . Make double click so you get inside of it.

Once you’re inside of it it will show this way....



Now, the left panel represents your computer. You need to go to the folder that has the website that has been generated by the software (you can paste the location in the location bar or you can use browse it).

Once you’re inside of it, select all the files as you can see in the picture (you can click the first item, then press “SHIFT” and click the down button until all the items are selected).

Once all the items have been selected, drag and drop them to the right panel.

That’s all!
