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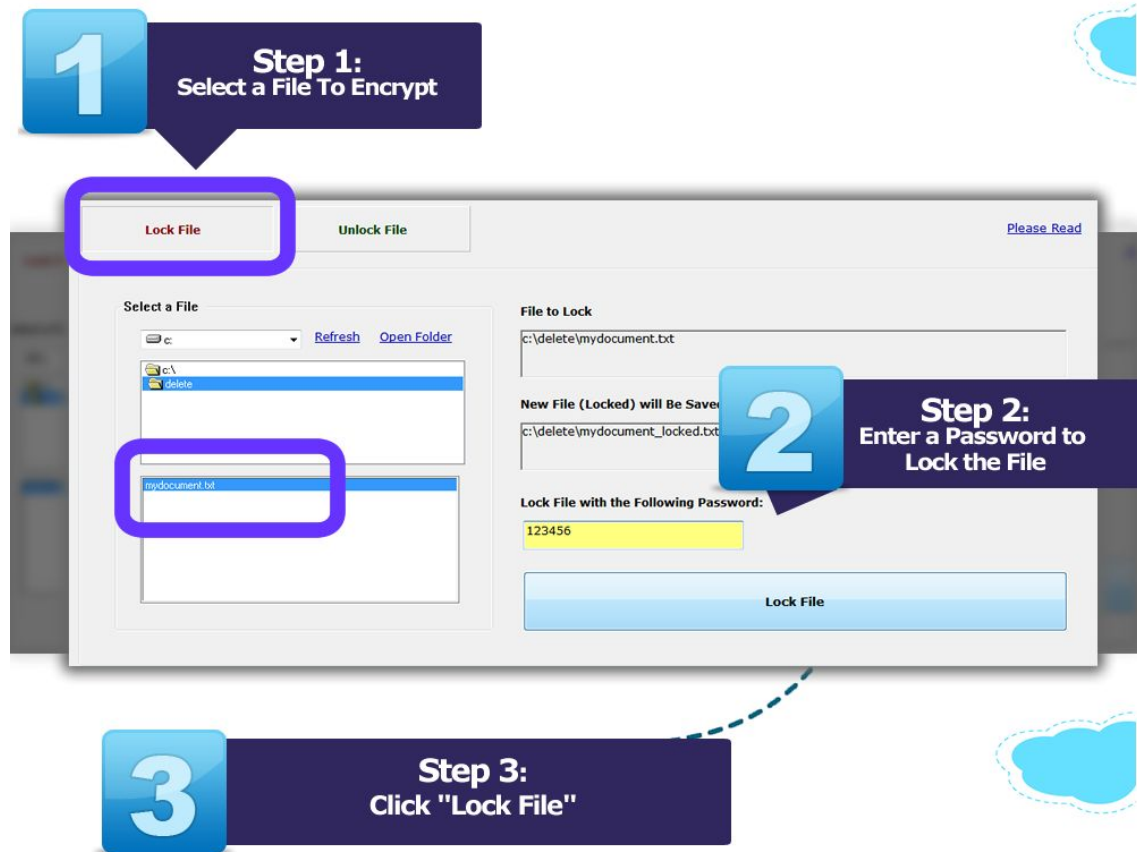
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# Using The Software.

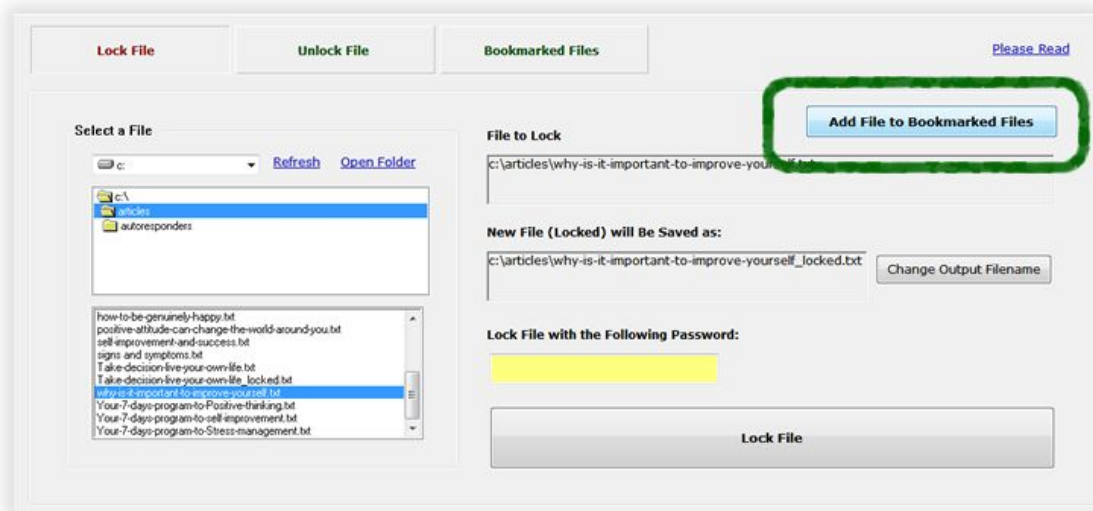
Using the software is really easy.



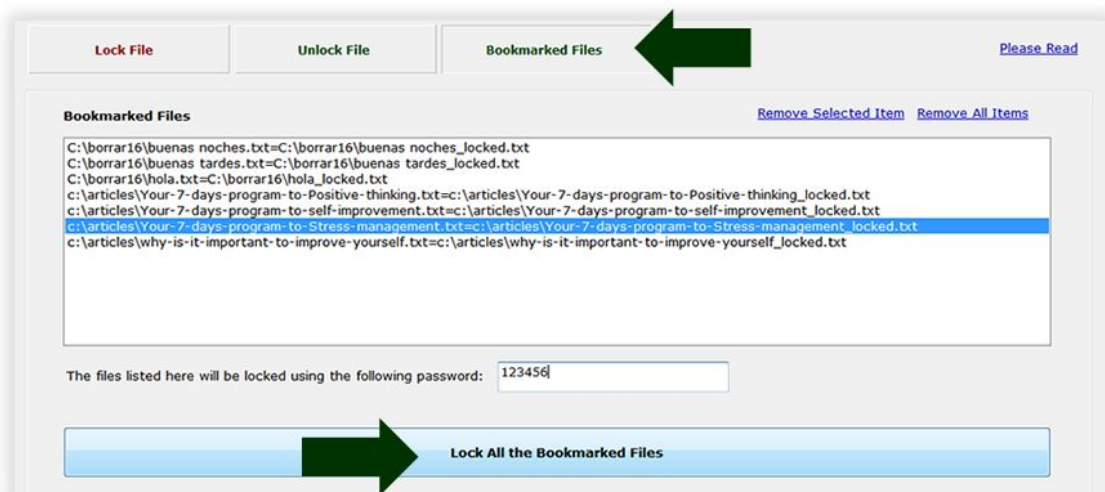
To unlock a file (that was previously locked with the software), just select it, go to the second tab ("Unlock File"), enter the right password and unlock it.

In the Pro version (which you already have), you can lock multiple files At once (if you frequently modify multiple files that then need to be locked, This feature will help you a lot).

To use it, just select a file and click the following button:



Then go to the “Bookmarked Files” tab, enter a password and lock the files.



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Comment:

- The list of “Bookmarked Files” is automatically saved to your disk (not the password, which you need to remember).
- These files will be locked on demand (you need to open the app and click “Lock all the Bookmarked Files” button).

Important:

- Always Keep a Backup of Your Original Files.
- When locking a file, DON'T use passwords that you use for sensitive accounts (like Home Banking etc).
- Always remember the password that you've used to lock a file as there's no way to recover a locked file without it.
- When unlocking a file, make sure that its name does NOT overwrite your Original file (this is to prevent data loss).
- Please notice that no encryption system is 100% secure but using no encryption at all is a guaranteed way of getting your data exposed to Strangers.
