Installing The Plugin.

Installing the plugin is like installing any other WP plugin.

Step 1: Go to the "Plugins" section and click.

Step 2: Click "Add New" and Upload the included zip file.

Step 3: Activate it.

Plugin Overview

If someone keeps visiting your sales page over and over, then it's time to do something. With our plugin you can redirect these visitors to any page of your choice:

- Discount page.
- Fake waiting list for a big scarcity effect (you can then send an autoresponder mentioning that your offer has been re-opened for some hrs)
- Modified version of your sales page.

Or any other kind of page.


Using The Plugin.

Using the plugin is really easy.

Just go to any wordpress page (or post) and enable the WPPushConvert Option.

Then enter a redirect url (where you want to do the redirect after this page has been visited for a certain number of times.)

Finally, define when do you want to trigger the redirect (example, after visit #2).
